I wish to share these beneficial Du'ā's that we have learnt from him, InshaaAllah.





أَخْمُدُ لِلَّهِ حَمْدًا كَثِيرًا طَيِّبًا مُبَارِكًا فِيهِ غَيْرَ مَكْفِيِّ، وَلاَ مُوَدَّع وَلاَ مُسْتَغْنَى عَنْهُ، رَبَّنَا

All praises are due to Allah alone - such praises which are in abundance and full of blessings. O, our Sustainer! We are not lifting this food regarding it to be sufficient or bidding it farewell (forever) or expressing no need for it.

1. BEFORE EATING

In the name of Allah and with the blessings of Allah.

2. WHEN ONE FORGETS TO TAKE THE NAME OF ALLAH AT THE BEGINNING OF EATING

If one forgets to take the name of Allah before eating, then one should recite the following Du'ā' when one remembers during the course of the meal:

With Allah's name in the beginning and at the end.

Rasulullah Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam has declared that Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'ala becomes extremely happy with a servant when he eats a morsel of food or has a sip of drink and thereafter praises Allah upon it and says:

ألحَمْدُ لله

5.1 AFTER EATING

Rasulullah Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam has mentioned that the previous (minor) sins of the one who recites this Du'ā' will be forgiven:

All praises are due to Allah alone, Who has fed me this food and has

granted it to me without any strength or ability of my own.

5.2 AFTER EATING

Rasulullah Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam has mentioned that the one who will recite

this Du'ā' will be absolved of reckoning for the food on the day of Qiyaamah.

O, Allah, grant us blessings in this food and feed us something better than it.

5.4 AFTER EATING

ٱلْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَطْعَمَنَا وَسَقَانَا وَجَعَلْنَا مُسْلِمِينَ

5.5 AFTER EATING

أَخْمَدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِيْ أَطْعَمَ وَ سَقَى وَسَوَّغَهُ وَ جَعَلَ لَهُ مَخْرَجًا

All praises are due to Allah alone, Who gave (us) food and drink, made it palatable and digested it and made a passage for the removal (of it's waste out of the body).

5.6 AFTER EATING

اَللَّهُمَّ أَطْعَمْتَ وَأَسْقَيْتَ وَأَغْنَيْتَ وَأَقْنَيْتَ وَأَقْنَيْتَ وَهَدَيْتَ وَأَحْيَيْتَ فَلَكَ الْحُمْدُ عَلَى مَا أَعْطَيْتَ

O, Allah, You have, fed us, given us water to drink, made us independent, made us content, guided us and granted us life, so all praises are due to You alone for what You have bestowed upon us.
